The resins you will be using are nontoxic, non-hazardous and odourless. A full range of opaque and metallic pigments will be made available for you to select and work with.

You have the option of taking your masterpieces home with you, or requesting we package and ship them to you a few days later (packing and shipping prices will vary on size and destination).

Attendees will be able to purchase all products demonstrated at steeply discounted prices for cash or card payments.

Bookings and Payment
